

2018 Barbour County Fair

Motorcycle and ATV Drag Races

Thursday, August 30, 2018 – Youth Night

Friday, August 31, 2018 – Adult Night

Registration Time: 5:00 PM

Race Time: 7:00 PM

The Barbour County Fair will once again have two nights of drag races beginning Thursday evening with Youth Night and followed up with Friday evening bringing the adult races.

This year's drag races will be "Jam Packed With Family Fun". Come on out and watch the youngest of the young race battery operated cars/atv's/motorcycles so Thursday evening in the open arena at the Barbour County Fair is the place you want to be. These little racers will be sure to pack your evening with family fun.

Youth classes include:

Motorcycles: 50-90 CC and 100 CC and up.

ATV: Battery operated, 0-50 CC, 51-90 CC, and 91CC and up.

Adult classes include:

Motorcycles: 2 stroke and 4 stroke

ATV: 2 stroke, 200-399CC, 4 stroke, 400CC, 4 stroke, Women, utility, side-by-side, 500CC and up 4 stroke and 450CC 4 stroke.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

All participants will be required to read and sign a wavier of liability and assumption of risk form as prescribed by the Barbour County Fair Association. All participants under the age of 18 will also need the signature of a parent/guardian. There are no exceptions.

- All classes are subject to change to single elimination, depending be announced in each class over the public-address system. We need to keep the area quiet. After the announcement, it is the participant's responsibility to make sure their name is announced in the correct class. We will give 5 minutes for any discrepancies to be brought to our attention, so the corrections can be made. After the races have started, the lineup cannot be changed.
- Trophies will be given to the top 3 riders in each class.
- Rider must have pants that go below the knees and a helmet to participate.
- No alcohol or drugs of any kind are allowed on the event grounds.
- If any official feels that a rider may not be able to handle the machine, the rider may not be allowed to participate in an event.
- Speed limit on grounds is limited to 5 mph. Speeders or horseplay is not allowed.
- Drivers have 2 minutes from the time they are called to report to the starting line.
- Before reporting to the line, drivers must be ready to run, if not, you may be disqualified.
- No burnouts will be allowed.
- Jumping the starting line or crossing the center line will be a loss for that race.

- After finishing a race, riders must go immediately to the return lane unless they know they have lost two times.
- Speeds in the return lane will be kept low, stunt riding (wheelies, stoppies, spinning, etc.) will not be tolerated in the return line. Riders can and will be disqualified for inappropriate behavior in the return lane.
- No chains, studs, paddles (over 1 inch tall) or spikes are allowed in or on the tires.
- Riding is only allowed between the pits and the drag strip, once you leave the arena, you can not return.
